THEN IT'S BACK DOWN AND AROUND THROUGH ALDEBARAN, THE EYE OF TAURUS THE BULL, TO BLUE SUPERGIANT AND ORION'S LEFT FOOT, RIGEL AND BACK TO SIRIUS.

THERE YOU HAVE IT – THE GIANT RUPEE! AS LINK MIGHT SAY: DO DILLY DO DILLY DOO!
