"THREE LUNAR ECLIPSES IN LESS THAN A YEAR"

DEAN: ON THE MORNING OF APRIL 4 WE WILL HAVE A TOTAL LUNAR ECLIPSE.

JAMES: THE THIRD ONE IN LESS THAN A YEAR.

(STOP & DROP)

DEAN: AT 4 AM ON MARCH 30, FACE WEST AND YOU LL SEE THE WAXING GIBBOUS MOON NEXT TO THE BRIGHT PLANET JUPITER.

JAMES: FOR THE NEXT FIVE MORNINGS THE MOON WILL SHIFT EAST AND GET FULLER.

DEAN: A LUNAR ECLIPSE CAN ONLY HAPPEN DURING A FULL MOON AND ON THE MORNING OF SATURDAY APRIL 4 EVERYTHING WILL BE LINED UP.

(STOP)

JAMES: YOU'LL FIRST SEE THE EARTH'S SHADOW ON THE MOON AT 6:15 AM EASTERN DAYLIGHT TIME.

DEAN: THE BAD NEWS IS THAT IT WILL BE TOUGH TO SEE ON THE EAST COAST, BUT STAR GAZERS IN THE MIDWEST CAN CATCH IT AS IT BEGINS.

JAMES: AROUND THE ROCKY MOUNTAINS YOU'LL SEE IT UNTIL TOTALITY.

DEAN: AND ALONG THE PACIFIC COAST YOU'LL SEE ALMOST ALL OF IT.
