ONE MORE THING FOR THE BRAVE... MONDAY, OCTOBER 23, VENUS REACHES ITS GREATEST ELONGATION WEST – MEANING IT'S GOING TO BE BEAUTIFUL AND BRIGHT *SHUDDER* IN THE MORNING.
