REMEMBER, NEVER LOOK AT AN ECLIPSE WITHOUT PROTECTION. ECLIPSE GLASSES ARE AVAILABLE MOST PLACES, BUT IF YOU MAKE A PINHOLE IN AN INDEX CARD AND HOLD IT UP, AND SHINE THE SHADOW OF THE SUN ON ANOTHER CARD! BINGO ECLIPSED!
